

Compliance statement of HELLENIC PETROLEUM Single-Member Societe Anonyme Refining, Supply and Sales of Oil Products and Petrochemicals (HELLENIC PETROLEUM R.S.S.O.P.P. S.A.) with the European Regulations REACH/CLP

REACH Regulation (Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation of CHemicals, (EC) No 1907/2006), requires that manufacturers and importers of substances on their own, in preparations or in articles, provide electronically the European CHemicals Agency (ECHA) with a series of information regarding their identity, characteristics, risks and safe use.

CLP Regulation (Classification, Labelling and Packaging, (EC) No 1272/2008), requires manufacturers, importers or downstream users of substances or mixtures to classify, label and package their hazardous materials appropriately before placing them on the market.

HELLENIC PETROLEUM R.S.S.O.P.P. S.A., in respect with the fundamental principles of REACH/CLP on the effective management of the hazards of substances, integrates full compliance into its activities.

Specifically:

- The Company is actively participating in various REACH consortia, joining its efforts with other Companies for the completion of the whole REACH project, including registration, evaluation and authorization, with the application of the Community competition rules.
- All REACH registrations for the manufactured and imported substances that were subject to the deadlines of REACH article 23 (November 30TH 2010, May 31ST 2013 and May 31ST 2018), depending on their tonnage band are in place
- The registration dossiers will continue to be updated according to REACH article 22 and Commission's implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/1435 or whenever this is required by ECHA's decisions during evaluation of dossiers and substances according to REACH processes.
- The extended Safety Data Sheets of the products (e-SDSs) will continue to be always up to date according to REACH and CLP Regulations. The e-SDSs contain in their annex the exposure scenarios for human health and environment per identified use, as well as the recommended risk management measures to downstream users. In addition, the Company fulfils its obligations within EU, regarding the compliance with the Annex VIII of CLP Regulation on harmonised information relating to emergency health response (available to poison centres).
- The dynamic list of the Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) as recommended by ECHA for inclusion in the Annex XIV of REACH (the authorisation list), is monitored in detail in order to comply with possible regulatory measures and also ensure the suppliers' compliance.
